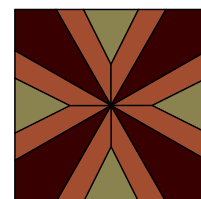
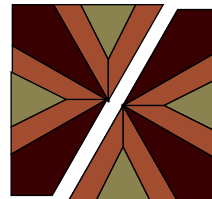
Make 4 for each block

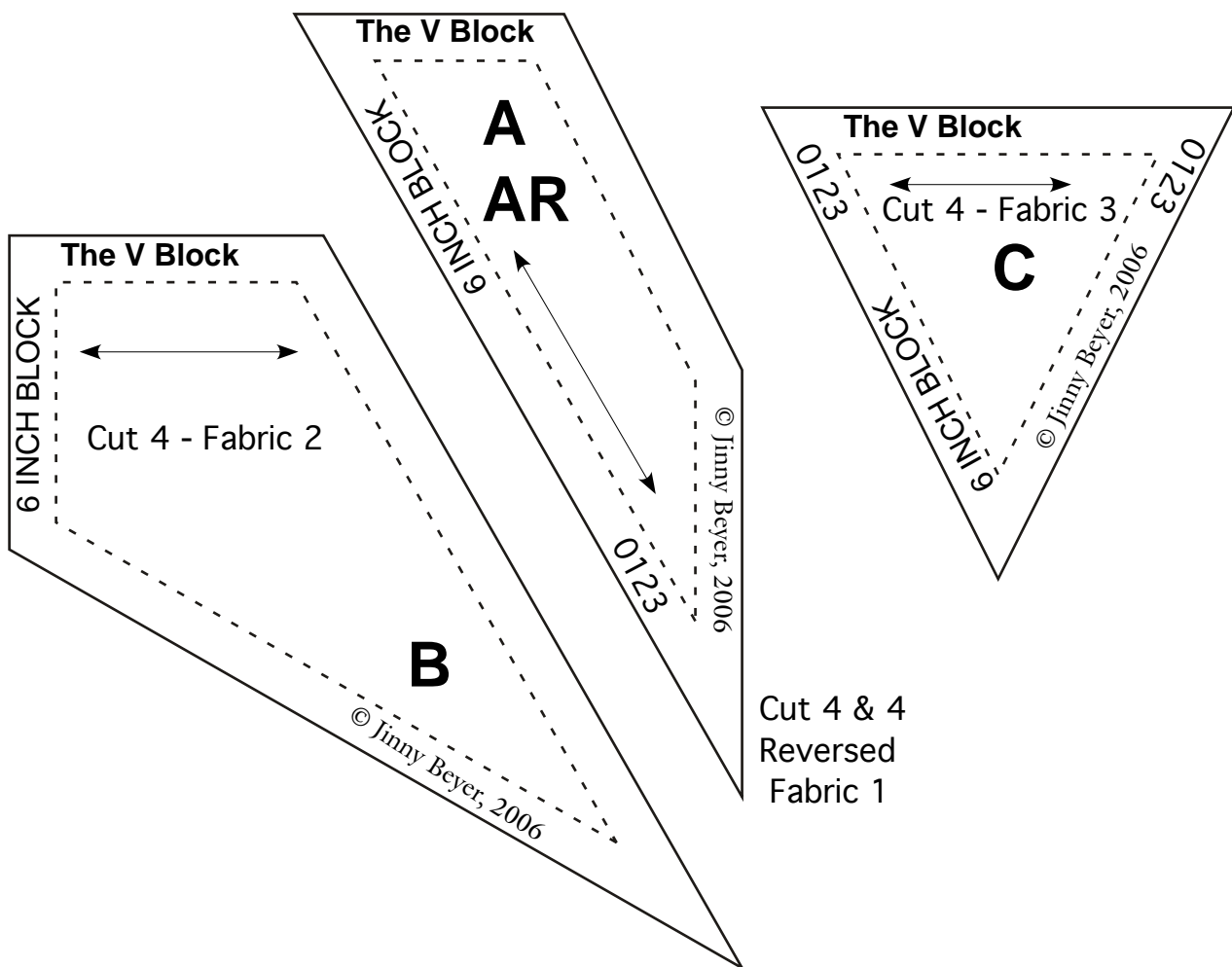

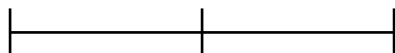

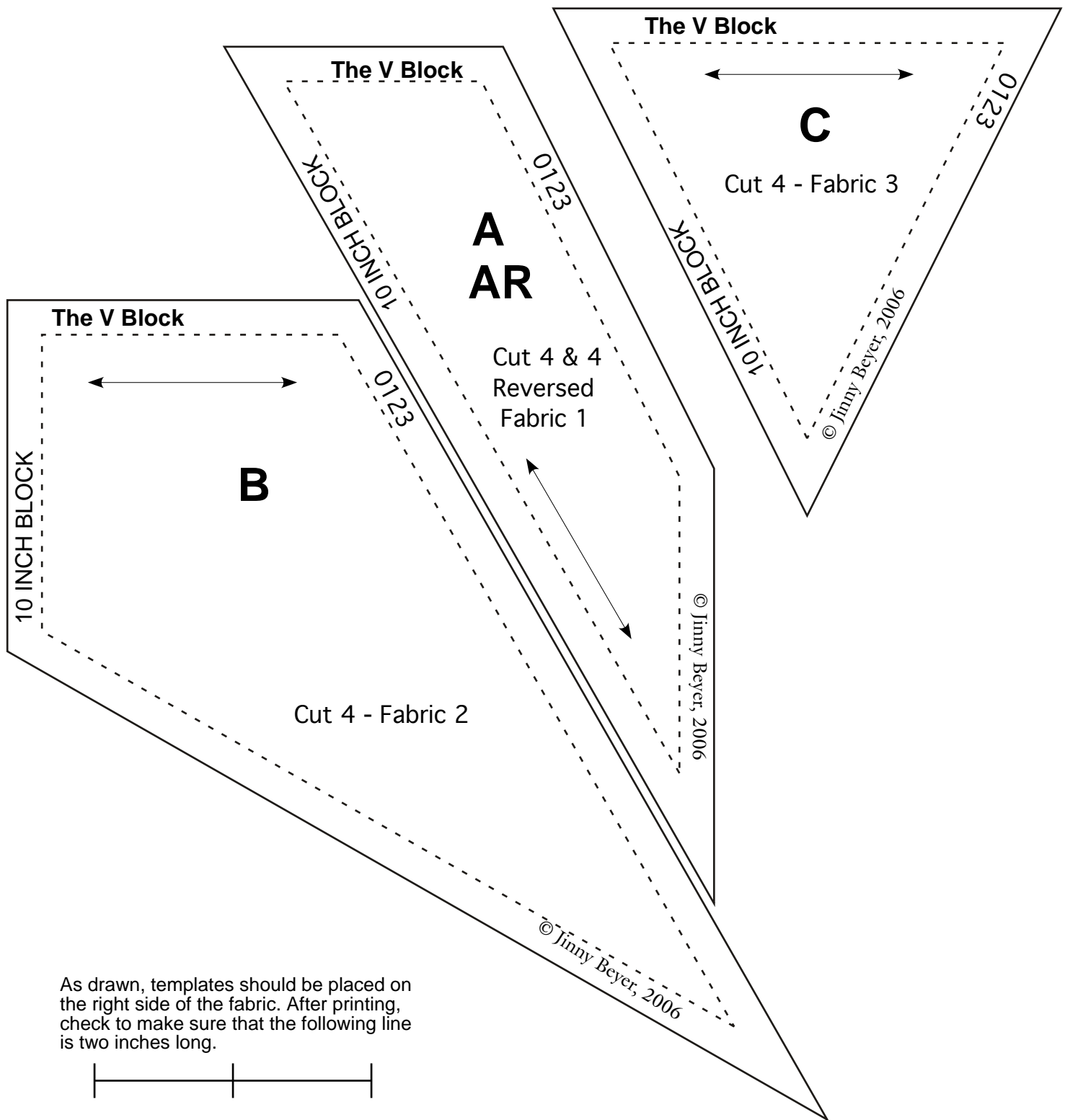


As drawn, templates should be placed on the right side of the fabric. After printing, check to make sure that the following line is two inches long.

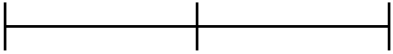

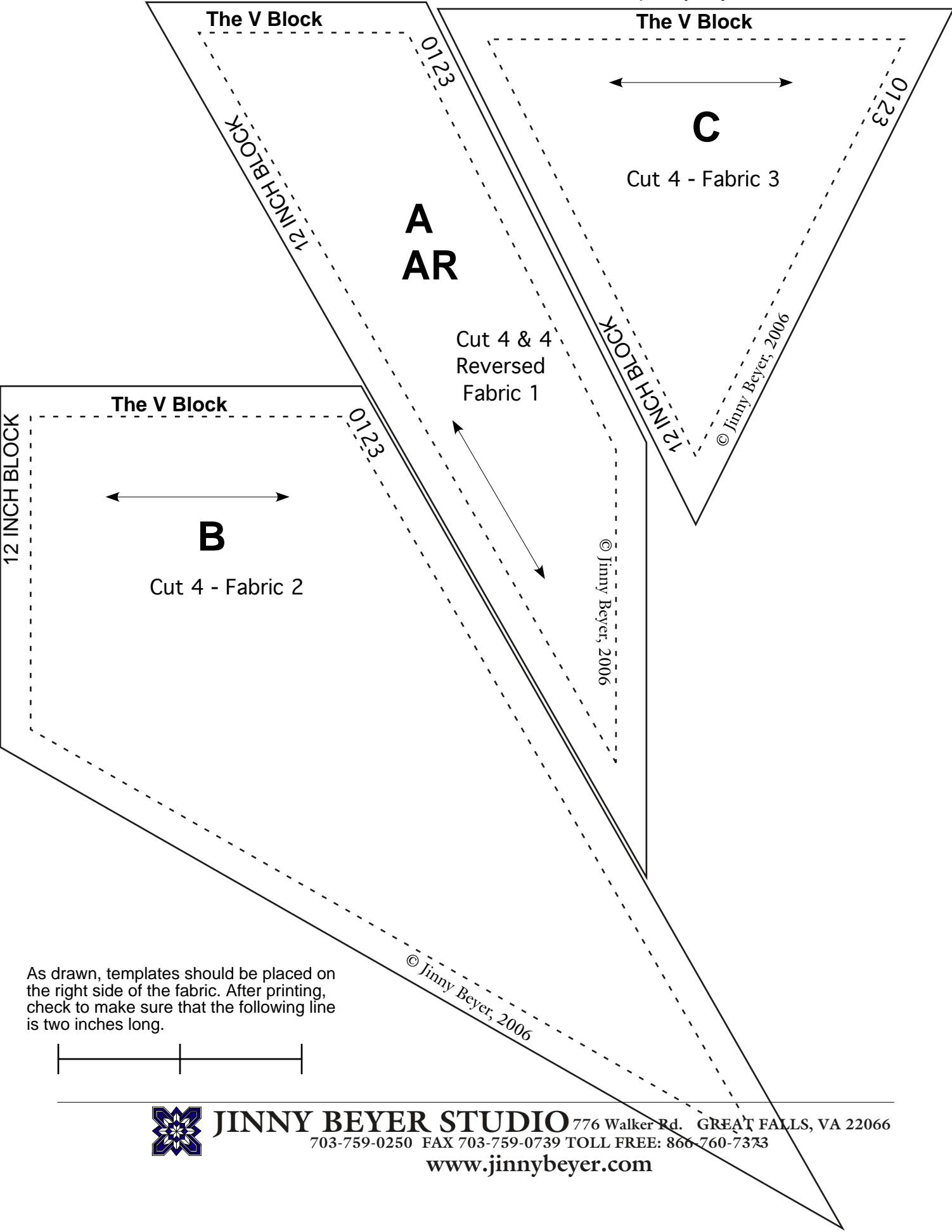
