The design of the pattern shown here is a 10" block. Different fabric placement will occur when making the block in one of the other two sizes.



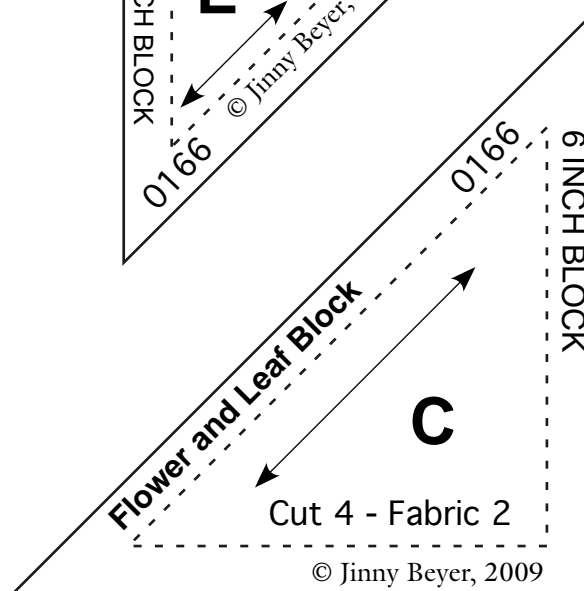
# Flower and Leaf Block

As drawn, templates should be placed on the right side of the fabric. After printing, check to make sure that the following line is two inches long.

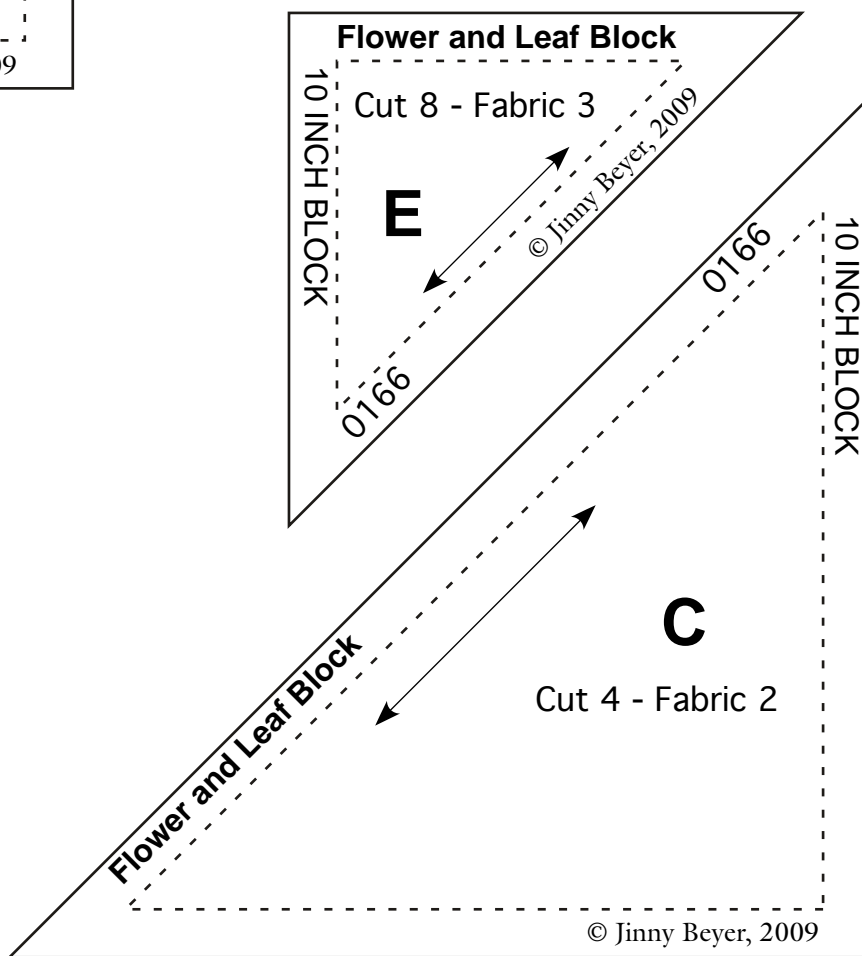
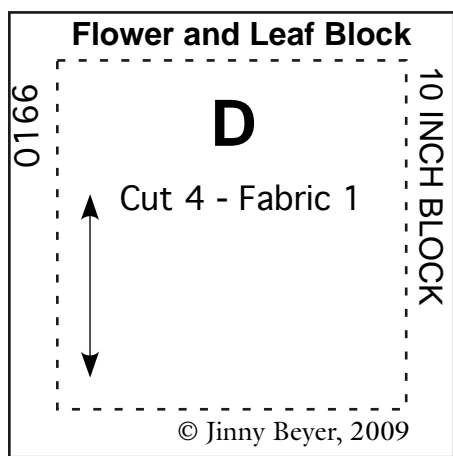
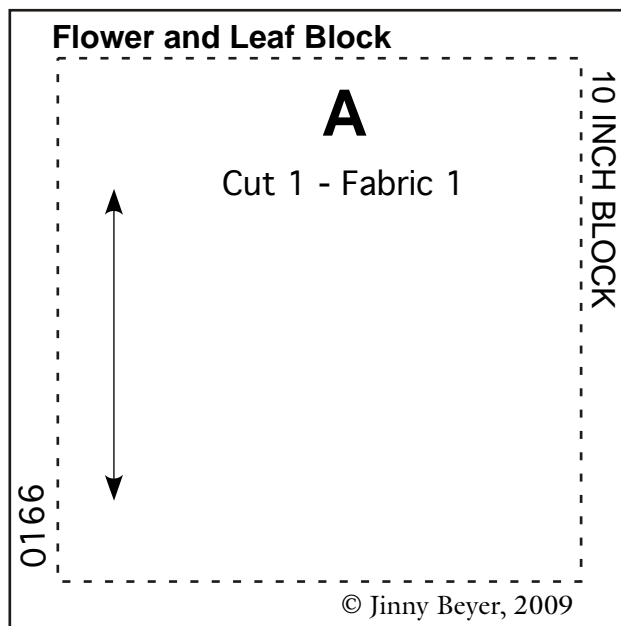
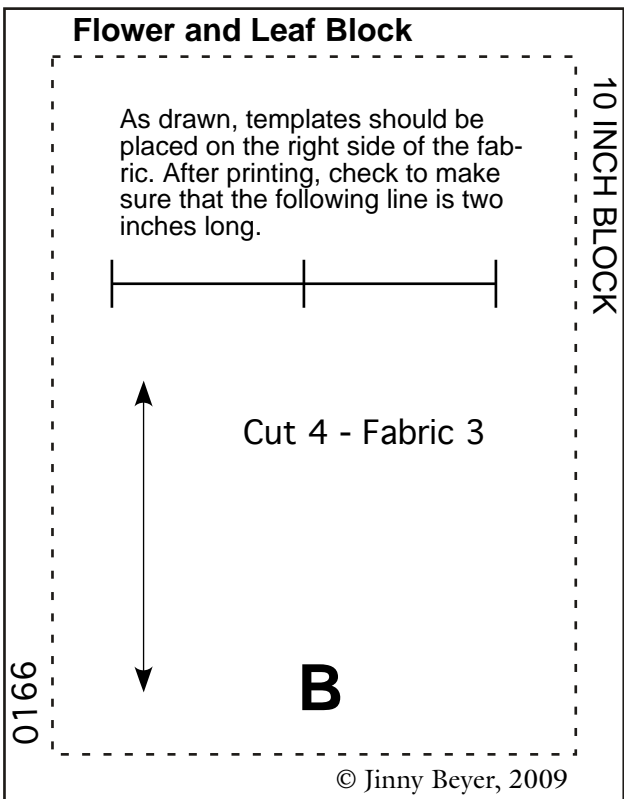
