## Wall Size Pattern Notes

Follow the main pattern, making the changes noted here.

**Fabric Notes.** The *Middle Border (Border 2)* fabric has been provided in a long length so the border strips do not need to be pieced. In Step 6, cut four pieces measuring 2" x Length of Fabric.

The *Binding* fabric has been provided as a separate ( $\frac{2}{3}$  yard) piece.



*Finishes 59" square.*

**Step 1.** Cut the number of strips as follows.

<b>Fabric 1</b> <i><math>\frac{1}{3}</math> yard</i>	A - Cut 3 strips @ $1\frac{3}{4}$ " B - Cut 2 strips @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ "	<b>Fabric 7</b> <i><math>\frac{1}{2}</math> yard</i>	M - Cut 3 strips @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ " N - Cut 4 strips @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ "
<b>Fabric 2</b> <i><math>\frac{1}{4}</math> yard</i>	C - Cut 1 strip @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ " D - Cut 1 strip @ $1\frac{3}{4}$ "	<b>Fabric 8</b> <i><math>\frac{2}{3}</math> yard</i>	O - Cut 2 strip @ $1\frac{3}{4}$ " P - Cut 2 strips @ $1\frac{3}{4}$ "
<b>Fabric 3</b> <i><math>\frac{1}{4}</math> yard</i>	E - Cut 1 strip @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ " F - Cut 2 strips @ $2\frac{3}{8}$ "	<b>Fabric 9</b> <i><math>\frac{1}{2}</math> yard</i>	Q - Cut 4 strip @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ " R - Cut 4 strips @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ "
<b>Fabric 4</b> <i><math>\frac{1}{3}</math> yard</i>	G - Cut 2 strips @ $1\frac{3}{4}$ " H - Cut 1 strip @ 3"	<b>Fabric 10</b> <i><math>\frac{2}{3}</math> yard</i>	S - Cut 4 strips @ $1\frac{3}{4}$ " T - Cut 4 strips @ $1\frac{3}{4}$ "
<b>Fabric 5</b> <i><math>\frac{1}{4}</math> yard</i>	I - Cut 2 strips @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ " J - Cut 1 strip @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ "	<b>Fabric 11</b> <i><math>\frac{1}{2}</math> yard</i>	U - Cut 4 strips @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ " V - Cut 6 strips @ $1\frac{1}{8}$ "
<b>Fabric 6</b> <i><math>\frac{1}{2}</math> yard</i>	K - Cut 2 strips @ $1\frac{3}{4}$ " L - Cut 1 strip @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ "	<b>Fabric 12</b> <i><math>\frac{3}{2}</math> yards</i>	<i>See below.</i>

*Fabric 12 (Border Print).* Separate the stripes as instructed.

*Border 1 (Narrow Stripes)* - Cut four pieces measuring 50".

*Border 3 (Wide Stripes)* - Cut four pieces measuring 78".

*Triangles A & B* - Follow the instructions in the pattern, cutting 16 identical A triangles and 16 identical B triangles.

**Step 3.** Make 16 blocks (versus 36).
