

## Month 5

### Step 1: Make the Half-Hexagon Centers

Follow the steps below to complete the compass blocks. Be sure to carefully match and pin the patches at the dots; take particular care to match the border print fabric designs.

- a) Sew together three identical M triangles to make a half-hexagon. Repeat to make two. Pin the two matching units together.



- b) Repeat for the remaining sets of M triangles.

### Step 2: Complete the Compass Blocks

In the next step, work with one set of matching units made in Month 3 at a time. Follow the steps below to complete a compass block. Once one block is complete, make a second, and so on. (Please note that the small triangle at the center of the foundation may be light or dark depending on the colorway you are making.)

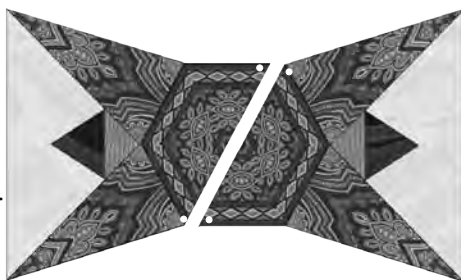


- a) Sew a unit made in Month 3/Step 2a to a unit made in Step 1a above, starting/stopping at the dots and using an inset seam.

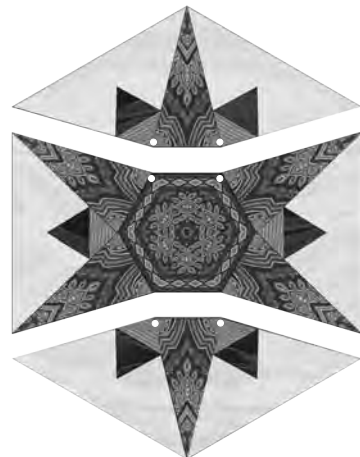
*Tip: Sewing with the half-hexagon on top gives you a good sewing line to follow: stitch just to the right of the stripe.*

Repeat to make two.

- b) Sew together the two units made in (a) above, starting/stopping at the dots.



- c) Sew the units made in Month 3/Step 2b to opposite sides of the unit made in (b) using inset seams.
