Step 1: Complete the Quilt Center

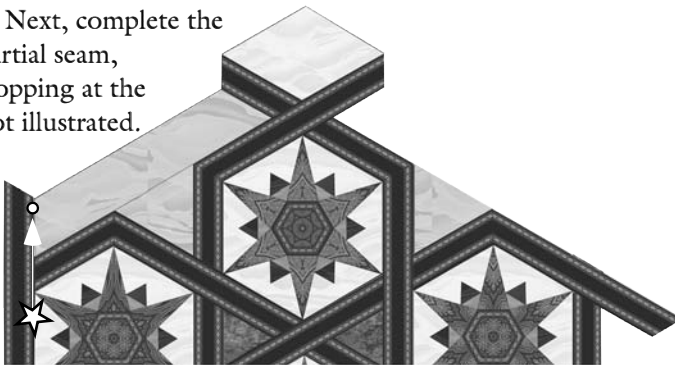
a) Sew together F, H and I pieces as shown, starting/stopping at the dot illustrated. Repeat to make six.



b) Moving the partially sewn strip out of the way, sew a unit made in (a) to the top-left of the quilt as shown, matching the dots.

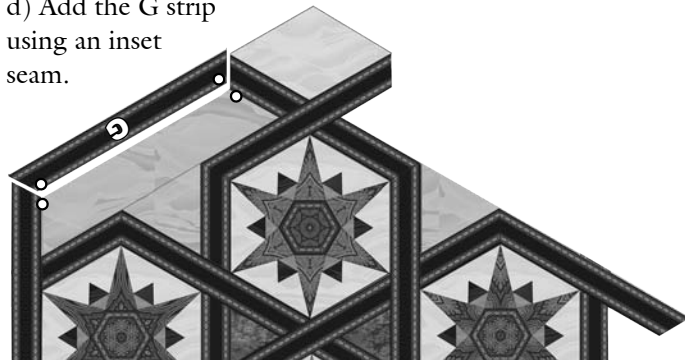


c) Next, complete the partial seam, stopping at the dot illustrated.



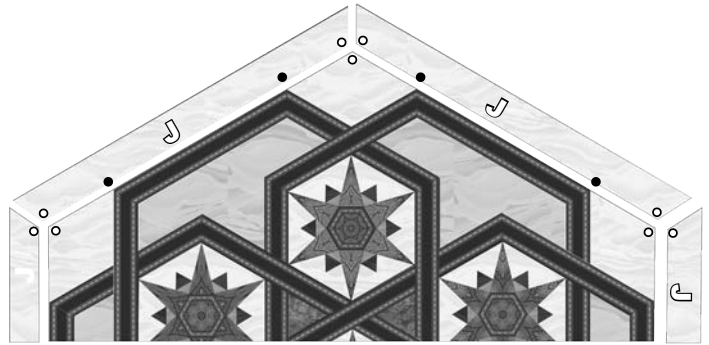
Piecing Order Note - As in Month 7, if you find that you are having difficulty matching the fabric designs for the short, mitred seams in (d) - (f), you may wish to sew those seams first, then sew the longer seams.

d) Add the G strip using an inset seam.



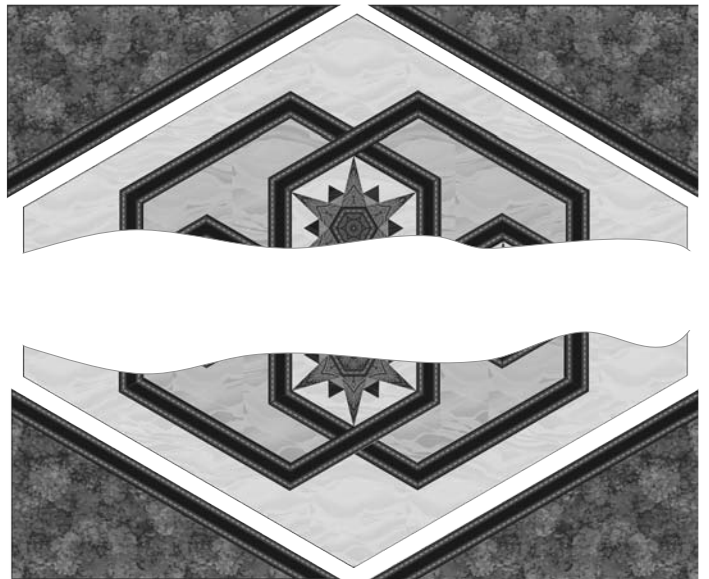
e) Working counter-clockwise, repeat the (b), (c) and (d) steps for the remaining five areas.

f) Pin a J strip to one side of the quilt, matching the dots, including lining up the interior ones (solid black in the illustration) with the seams in the mini-stripe. Sew, starting/stopping at the dots. Repeat for all sides. Lastly, sew the short, angled seams to join the J strips.



g) Carefully remove the paper foundations from the compass blocks.

h) Sew the corner units made in Month 4/Step 6 to the quilt center at the top and bottom.
